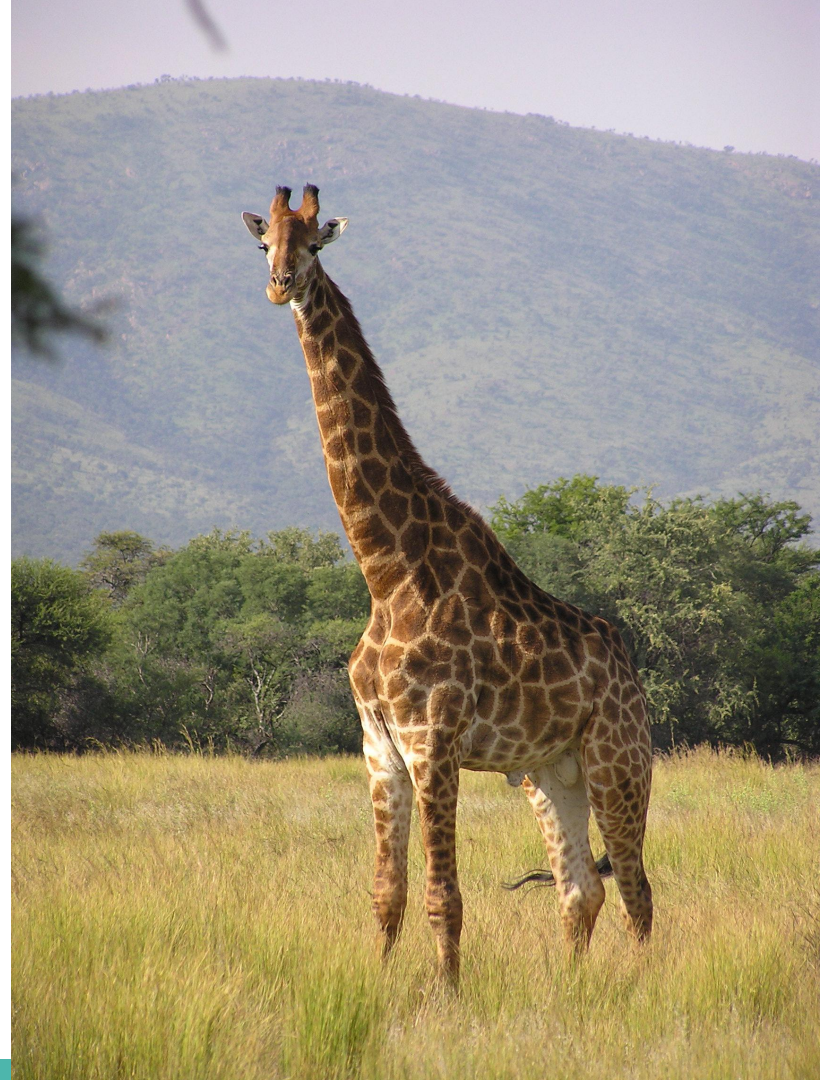
Introduce yourself!

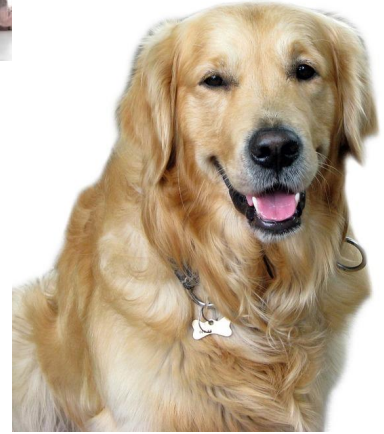
